Flexible Glossy Magnetic Cards

Printing and Application Instructions

Copy/Print on the paper side of the media using compatible Inkjet Printer.

To prevent a paper jam, make sure the sheet is not bent or warped or corners folded BEFORE loading.

Load the magnetic paper by hand ONE SHEET at the time (pressing FF/Ready) This is the best way to make sure it loads correctly.

To successfully print on to this media you must use a desktop publishing or a graphic utility or draw program or a special software to make business cards one that will support the standard 2" X 3 1/2" 5 up name card format on 8.5" X 11" sheet.

Most desktop graphic design and desktop publishing programs will support this template.

Print on the test sheet to test the layout before printing on the magnetic paper.

Helpful hint: *We strongly recommend leaving a white margin around your design (or graphic) to avoid running into problems lining up your cards. Also avoid using horizontal and vertical lines close to the edges of the cards.*

After printing:

To: separate the cards from the sheet bend it along the perforated lines and fold back and forth until the cards fall free from the sheets.
